# 1999 Commodore's Year **End Report**

#### The Nationals

Although we didn't quite match the number of Gold medals attained at Whistler in 1998 we still had a productive year at this year's Nationals in Ottawa, retaining our overall 9<sup>th</sup> place finish. A win in the Junior Men's War Canoe, our first since 1962, was the highlight of the day for us. This was closely followed by a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish in the Senior Women's War Canoe event. Roumen and Gueorgui Nikolov were silver medal winners in both the 500m and 1,000m Senior Men's C-2, but disappointed to be disqualified after winning the 200m event. Coach Rob Stott had a big day in coxing the Junior War Canoe to its Gold medal, as well as paddling to Bronze in the Junior C-4, Senior C-4, and Open C-4 200m events. Head Coach Paul Nikolov won his first CCA Gold as a member of the Junior War Canoe.

#### **Fundraising**

We held several major fundraising events that helped towards the purchase of a new war canoe and a 50 hp motor for our pontoon boat. We started the year with the "Hair of the Dog" fun walk/run and raised just over \$2,000. Along with our major fundraiser, the "200 Club" extravaganza, the "Corporate North Canoe Challenge", and the five Glenn Miller Dances, we were able to help our athletes in a big way.

#### **Summer Sports Camp**

Our camp director, Lynn Roworth, did an outstanding job and was able to fill the camp beyond capacity for most of the summer. The camp not only provides regular sports such as baseball and soccer, but also introduces youngsters to paddling.

#### Membership

Membership was up substantially this year, especially with the Bantams. The Master class membership

remained about the same as the Masters have to belong to the main Balmy Beach Club as well as the Canoe Club, making it is difficult for us to recruit new members. Unfortunately, we didn't have as many of last year's Bantams returning to move into the Midget class.

Congratulations to the Malvern Junior football team who won the TSSAA junior championship with paddlers, Ashley Hines, Luke Wheeler and Derek McAndrews on the team. The senior team won the TSSAA tier two championship with Christian Wright on the team.
